

# Bed Making Competition Rules & Regulations

The Senior Bed Making Competition will take place during HORECA JORDAN Exhibition. We are delighted to organize the annual Bed Making Competition that takes place in Zara Expo (Grand Hyatt Hotel) Amman/Jordan.

Participants will race to make a bed according to the following General Rules & Regulations. The Bed-Making Competition is one of the many events that will be held during HORECA JORDAN EXHIBITION dated 10- 12 October, 2017 at Zara Expo (Grand Hyatt Hotel) Amman/Jordan

#### **BED MAKING COMPETITION GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. Competitors should wear their work uniforms during the competition. Wearing slippers or shorts is not allowed.
- 2. The hotel's name or logo <u>should not</u> be visible to the judges during the competition. It may be placed on the uniform once the judging is completed.
- 3. The date and time of the competition will be sent to participants at least a week in advance to the date of the competition. Competitors should be present half an hour before their competition time. Competitors who arrive late or show up on a different day will be disqualified.
- 4. Participation fees are only 70 JD per participant.
- 5. The decision of the judges in all cases is final. Competitors have no right to appeal.

- 6. Competitors contravening any of the Rules and Regulations of the event may be disqualified.
- 7. The Organizers reserve the right to reject any entry, which does not comply with the rules or with any specific requirement.
- 8. The Organizers reserve the right to rescind, modify or add on any of the above rules and regulations and their interpretation of these are final. They also reserve the right to limit the number of participants, modify any rules, cancel any competition, or cancel/postpone the whole competition should it be deemed necessary.

#### **SPECIFIC REGULATIONS**

Each participant will be provided with the following supplies:

- Mattress (King size)
- Mattress Protector
- First Sheet
- Second sheet
- Duvet
- Duvet Case
- 4 Pillows
- 4 Pillow Cases (2 designed, 2 plain)
- Bed throw/Protectors

## Each participant will get his new set of (First sheet/Second Sheet/Duvet case/Pillow case)

#### **Scale of penalties**

Points will be deducted for:

- Not respecting time
- Not wearing a professional uniform
- Revealing the contestant's or establishment's name on uniforms
- Not abiding by the rules of the personal appearance

#### Participants should observe the following rules:

- 1. The Mattress protector should be placed evenly on top of the Mattress,
- 2. The First Sheet should be placed evenly and tucked tightly from all sides.
- 3. The Second Sheet should be placed with the sides even not tucked in, the end of the bed turned to be even with the sides. The top part of the sheet should be folded neatly with the duvet.
- 4. The duvet must be properly filled in the duvet cover

- 5. The duvet must be placed evenly from the sides and tucked folded from the top of the bed with the Second Sheet.
- 6. Pillows should be correctly filled in their cases; the 2 cases with any design should be on top of the plain cases along with the pillow protectors.
- 7. No running around is allowed

## JUDGING CRITERIA:

The Bed-Making Competition is based on **speed**, **accuracy and skill**. The timing of the competition will begin once the judges indicate so and will be stopped as soon as the participant completes the bed-making. The time taken to make the bed, the tidiness, the quality, the presentation and overall look of the bed are the main judging criteria for the competition

# Following is the judging criteria used in this competition:

• Technique	50 points	
The way the corners, duvet, pillow cases are set		
Sheet/Second sheet/Corners	10 points	
Duvet	10 points	
Pillow cases	10 points	
Bed throw/Protector	10 points	
Overall Bed appearance	10 points	
• <b>Timing</b> It should be less than 7 min to	<b>30 points</b> get full grade	

Less than 7 minutes	30 points
Between 7 and 10 minutes	15 points
More than 13 minutes	0 points

#### Overall Impression

20 points

The person must have good manners, be knowledgeable, self-controlled, possess a sense of humor, be eloquence and have language skills.

Cleanliness & Neatness: Uniform, grooming, perfume in moderation, no excessive use of makeup, jewelry should not be worn when in uniform, hair must always be neat and gentlemen should be clean shaved

60-69 points Merit Certificate70-79 points Bronze Medal and certificate80-89 points Silver Medal and certificate90-100 points Gold Medal and certificate
